



The Canada Digital Adoption Program (CDAP), by the Government of Canada, helps small and medium-sized enterprises (SMEs) adopt digital technologies to increase their competitiveness. Eligible businesses will receive a grant² to build their digital plan, followed by a 0% loan of up to \$100,000¹ to implement it.

Closing the digitization gap between Canadian businesses and their global competitors

Objectives

Eligibility

- o Canadian privately owned, for profit businesses with 1-499 full time employees and \$500,000 of annual revenues in one of the previous three years.
- o Must meet all requirements to be deemed a Canadian-controlled Private Corporation (CCPC)

Additional Student Placement

Stream 2 is funding up to 16,800 students and recent graduates to help Canadian businesses implement digital technologies.

BDC Loans

Stream 2 SMEs who completed their digital adoption as part of the CDAP program can submit a loan request to BDC for further financing. If accepted, they can receive up to \$100,000 0% interest loan.
